Large photo's

Those who visited Frankfurt or Vienna saw several large color photo's of 50 x 70 cm in which the SA logo has been incorporated (small in the lower right corner). You can order them with the attained fax form. The price will depend on the number we get ordered and will vary from Dfl 65,- downwards each negative and Dfl 95,- each photo (but don't expect it to be much less). See attached Fax form for the types available.

As we have to order the negatives and photo's together for a better price, the deadline for your order will be May 4th (next monday). Orders coming afterwards will be processed though against the (highest) price mentioned. Please give us your reaction soon so we can act soon.

Flight Cases

Since the beginning of this year SA has a new official division. This division called "Stage Accompany Flight Cases" is designing and producing all kinds of flight cases for the industry. As we reported before, over the recent years, Stage Accompany has been asked many times to produce flight cases for companies outside its own "audio world". This has lead to a great expertise in this field, and in order to answer to the many requests for different types of flight cases, a special division has been set up.

Flight cases are produced for a great variety of clients; Philips electronics, Unisys computers, offshore companies, standbuilders, rental companies, classical orchestra's, promotion teams, etc. etc.

The flight case division is managed by John Bakker, who can be reached at our Stage Accompany office in Hoorn. John speaks excellent English, German, French, Italian and of course Dutch. Feel free to contact him for (special!, not the regular) flight case orders.

As this is about special custom made cases, it is best when we do have direct contact with the client to prevent mistakes as many aspects have to be discussed (dimensions, color, inner construction etc.). You will receive a few percent of the order, depending on order size.

Price list '92

We didn't explain the changes in the pricelist to you (though we hope it was quite clear). There we go:

All order numbers have changed. To order a product just specify the "type" entry in the list and the quantity you want. In general all options should be specified separately with only one exception: The flight cased version of the cabinets is now listed as a separate "type" with a "S" behind its number.

Example: suppose you want to order two C 14S cabinets with castors; stand adaptor and front cover together with four C 24 cabinets (also with stand adaptor) packed into two flight cases. Two of the top cabinets will be used with a stand tube and two with a separate stand. For amplification you want two SA 1600 amplifiers and a X60A crossover (at 100 Hz; 24 dB Bessel slope). The amplifiers will be housed in a 7 HE rack together with a connector panel. SA does not have a standard panel for this system though a special version of the CP 2 will fit. The cabling must be 15 meters.
