Serial numbers

From 1-8-'91 the serial numbers in general are different. We use now two numbers less. Before, the first 4 characters displayed the year and month of production (e.g 9101xxxxxx means januari 1991). Now only the year is displayed (e.g. 91xxxxxx).

Product News

Connector panels

The connector panels with article numbers 0310.0064 and 0310.0065 are no longer in production.

Blue Box stand

We had problems with the delivery of the heavy (Blue Box) stands. Now, we produce them ourselves so delivery is no problem anymore (they are in stock). For clearity, we are talking about article no. 0320.0097, capable of carrying two Blue Boxes.

Of course, the stand is also usefull for, for example, Champion 4529 cabinets etc.

Champions

The new 4529 & 4527 Champions are ready! We hope to supply you as soon as possible with the new documentation. In general the look is the same as the Performer series though the sides are not angled. A new developed crossover, a new driver protection and application of the SA 8526 Compact Driver (before: 8525) make these Champions improved, reliable, well sounding full range cabinets.

Compared to the previous design, the maximum HF output has increased 3 dB. Also the new cabinets are to be used only passive. This reduces cost effectively and gives a well distinction between Performer and Champion series. In fact the Champions will have the same price as their predecessors though we now mount the 8526 Compact Driver.

Leaders

The first redesigned SA 4627 Leader has come out of production last week. Besides the increased maximum HF output due to apllication of the SA 8526 Compact Driver and the improved driver protection, the cabinets do have a considerable "lower profile". The look is towards the Performer and this cabinet is also only to be used passive.

The other Leaders will follow soon.

SA 800 & 1600

A few small changes are made:

800 & 1600:

The multifuse for the fan, located on the front print 1531.1601/2, is increased a little in capacity. You can find this multifuse on page 16 of the service manual. From now on type MF-R040 will be applied (before: MF-R030). Article number: 1885.0040. This change is effectuated starting at serial numbers 9104160062 (1600) and 91080036 (800).

1600 only:

Transistors T10 and T11, located on the amplifier board (see page 21 service manual) have now a small cooling sink applied. We strongly advise you to update amplifiers with these sinks as these transistors may get to hot without. They are applied in the factory starting at serial number 9105160071. If you have send in a 1600 after June 1 for servicing, the sinks are applied by our service department.

You can order these sinks with article number 1331.0932. For one 1600 amplifier you have to order 4 heat-sinks!

PPA 1200

We had some questions regarding the 5 Volt update in the PPA 1200. It turns out we didn't inform you about a change in the PPA 1200.

Since november 1990 (starting at serial number 9011120503) the 5 Volts upgrade print is no longer installed. The problem is solved in a different, better way (12 Volt instead of 6 Volt relais and some other minor changes). We are sorry we did not inform you correctly.

At the end of this week, the service manual update will be send to you by post.

Paverrotti visited Holland

The solist Paverrotti recently visited Holland for a concert in the Ahoy, Rotterdam. Philips decided that it would be nice to have the concert also in the PSV stadium in Eindhoven. Therefore, the Dutch PTT (post & telecommunication services) arranged a transmitter plus receiver for the video and audio signal. In the PSV stadium, a large nitstar LCD vidiwall was used for the videosignal. The audiosignal was fed to four Performer 2-26 sets for the main listening area (3500 seats). The special business seats were covered with two Blue boxes; four Personals and 16 small fill-in systems from BNS. For amplification, four PPA-1200's were used.

The job was done by Monk Road Service and coordinated by Jaco Bouwmeester, our new Stage Rent Manager.
